

GOLD COAST AHA SCHOOLING SHOW RULES:

- 1) All Riders **MUST** check-in, register and sign the release forms **BEFORE** mounting a horse.
- 2) The safety of riders and horses is of paramount importance; unsafe practices puts everyone at risk. Any rider, trainer, coach, or attendee determined by management to be handling a horse or behaving in an unsafe manner around horses may be asked to take a safer approach. If not cooperative, management reserves the right to ask them to leave the grounds.
- 3) Age of Horse and Rider is as of January 1, 2025. Horses must be serviceably sound to compete.
- 4) Acceptable schooling devices include snaffles, martingales, cavessons, and hackamores – ALL AGES.
- 5) Leg wraps are acceptable. Riding two-handed is acceptable.
- 6) Juniors (17 yrs. and under) **MAY NOT** show or handle colts or stallions.
- 7) Exhibitors may ride in **non-eligible classes by turning their number upside down. You will not be judged** in that class.
- 8) The show committee reserves the right to combine, cancel, divide, or add classes. The judge's decision is final.
- 9) The two-minute gate rule will be enforced.
- 10) Ribbons will be awarded through Fifth place.
- 11) Exhibitor numbers must be visible at all times. If on a saddle pad, they must be visible on both sides of the saddle pad. You are only allowed to compete under the number assigned to you and your horse.
- 12) Following show attire is required:
Long pants, shirts with sleeves, and heeled riding boots or shoes are required in all classes.
- 13) Hard hats and safety helmets are acceptable in all classes.
- 14) Food service **will not** be available at this show. Complimentary coffee & muffins will be served in the a.m.
- 15) **LONE OAK ARENA RULES: PLEASE help us continue to be able to use these facilities.**
 - a) Absolutely **NO LUNGEING** in the **MAIN ARENA- NO EXCEPTIONS**. Use Round pen or Square pen – **10 min limit**.
 - b) All persons under eighteen (18) years of age **MUST** wear a helmet (ASTM-Standard & SEI certified).
 - c) All dogs/pets on grounds must be on a leash. Keep your area picked up.
 - d) No cleaning out of trailers in the parking lot or on the grounds. Scoop your poop and take it home. 😊
Clean up after your horse. Pick up all manure, feed, and shavings from around your trailer before leaving.
 - e) Stalls are not to be used unless asked for at registration. Any exhibitor found to be using an unassigned stall for tying up a horse or as a tack stall, will be charged a day stall fee of \$35.00.

NOTE: This schooling show will use a Ticket System.

Each ticket is good for entrance into ANY class of your choice. Simply present your ticket at the entry gate and enter the class.

Unused tickets purchased at the first schooling show are good for any Gold Coast AHA show offered in 2025.

DIRECTIONS TO LONE OAK EQUESTRIAN ARENA, 11690 Murphy Ave, San Martin:

NOTE: These are recommended routes to avoid the steep banked railroad crossing at Church Ave & Monterey Rd

SOUTHBOUND - Recommended route

South on US-101, exit 362 to right onto E SAN MARTIN AVE, proceed to 4-way Stop Sign and take left on LLAGAS AVE, in approx. 1.5 mi. turn left on Church Ave, first right on Murphy Ave, show entrance on the left passed covered arena.

NORTHBOUND - Recommended route

North on US-101, exit MASTEN AVE, turn right on Masten Ave; turn left on COLUMBET AVE, turn left on Church Ave (Stop Sign); over the freeway take left on Murphy Ave, show entrance on the left passed covered arena.
